

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

## Reimbursement Chair Report:

Marlys Fisher, UPCRA Reimbursement Committee Chair, is requesting help from all **pulmonary rehabs** in ND to help advocate for more covered ND Blue Cross phase 2 pulmonary rehab sessions.

As you know, BC of ND covers a mere three pulmonary rehab sessions; wholly insufficient to help our COPD patients! We cannot do them justice in educating them to effectively manage their disease, improve their ability to perform ADL's, take their medications properly, teach them airway clearance, assist them in improving their breathing and physical stamina through exercise, etc.

Marlys is asking that at least one person from each pulmonary rehab prepares a letter for ND BC and emails it to Marlys: ( <a href="mailto:fishers@minot.com">fishers@minot.com</a>) via an attachment by Wednesday, **April 10th**.

She will then take the letters to the chair of the BC board to present at their April meeting in Fargo.
