Gayla Oakley is the Director of Cardiology Services and Prevention at the Boone County Health Center in Albion, Nebraska. She has been active in the Nebraska Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation Network (NCVPRN) and held many leadership roles including President. Gayla serves on the AACVPR Board of Directors as secretary and is the editor of News and Views. She continues to serve on the senior leadership team for AACVPR program certification. Her list of accomplishments includes; AACVPR master fellow, AACVPR distinguished service award, Certified Cardiac Rehab Professional (CCRP), March of Dimes Excellence in Nursing Award, and the NCVPRN Distinguished Member Award.



Pat McKone, Senior Director – Health Promotions and Public Policy - American Lung Association, has worked with lung health programming for over forty years. Ms. McKone's work has included tobacco cessation programs for adults and youth, limiting youth access to tobacco, public and school-based education, raising awareness of the impact of tobacco in those with mental illness and/or substance abuse disorders, as well as advocacy around limiting exposure to second hand smoke, smoke free housing, point of sale, and e-cigarettes.

Pat founded the Leadership Academy, a statewide partnership between mental health substance abuse and tobacco control leaders in Minnesota working together over the past three years to address disparities related to tobacco in these populations. Ms. McKone was the 2017 recipient of the American Lung Association's Distinguished Professional Service Award and in 2018 was recognized as part of the Blue Cross Trailblazer Award.
